Greetings Mohr Eagles!!

Mohr Elementary and the Mohr PTA would like to remind parents to keep their children's safety in mind when dropping off and picking up their children from school and other activities. Teach your children these strategies to remain safe:

PASSWORD: Work with your child to come up with a password that is easy to remember, but not obvious to a stranger. The child should not go with a stranger that does not know the password. Teach your child to seek out a school employee if this situation should occur.

KEEP A SAFE DISTANCE: If a child is confronted with a stranger attempting to lure them to a car, they should know to always keep a safe distance from that person. This could prevent the child being grabbed and forced into a car. Train children to not allow the stranger to get close enough to touch them.

MEETING PLACES: When meeting your child after school, or from after-school events, be clear about the exact location and time, and be on time. Choose a pick-up point that is not isolated and out-of-view of supervising personnel.

PHONE CONTACTS: Have your child carry a card with multiple phone numbers of people who can help them in their backpack or on their person in case the designated pick-up person cannot get to the location.

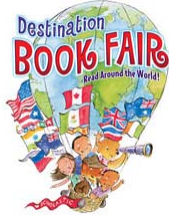

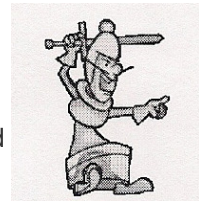

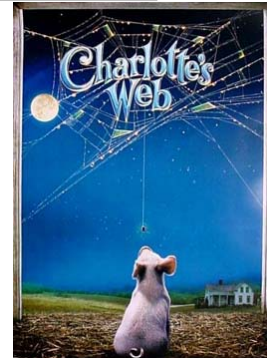
